Ilsefins Garter shawl in Noro Iro

Yarn: 100g Noro Iro (120 m/132 yards)

Needles: 12 mm / approx US 17

Abbreviations:

K - knit

Yo - Yarn Over

Kfb – Knit front and back. Increase stitch by knitting through the front loop, keep the stitch on the needle and knit another stitch through the back loop. I.e. knit 2 stitches in one stitch. k2tog – knit two stitches together.

RS – Right side WS – Wrong side



Directions:

Cast on 7 stitches.

Row 1 (RS): k2, yo, kfb, k1, kfb, yo, k2 (you should have 11 stitches on your needle)

Row 2 and all WS rows: Knit

Row 3: k2, yo, **k1**, kfb, k3, kfb, **k1**, yo, k2 (15 stitches)

Row 5: k2, yo, **k3**, kfb, k3, kfb, **k3**, yo, k2 (19 sts)

Row 7: k2, yo, **k5,** kfb, k3, kfb, **k5**, yo, k2 (23 sts)

Row 9: k2, yo, **k7**, kfb, k3, kfb, **k7**, yo, k2 (27 sts)

Continue in this manor for as long as the yarn last. You will need approximately 2-3 meters (2.2-3.3 yards) yarn for cast-off.

Cast-off loosely, like this: Knit 2 stitches, slip the stitches that you just knitted back to the left hand needle, k2tog, *slip the stitch back to the left hand needle, k2tog*. Repeat the instruction between the asterisks (*) until only one stitch remains. Pull the yarn through the last stitch.

Block the shawl gently and weave in loose ends.
